





Always wear goggles or eye protective gear to protect your eyes when shooting




Disassembling or modifying the gun may affect the gun's performance and void manufacturer's warranty




Never put your finger onto the trigger unless you are ready to fire




Never point the muzzle at people or animals



Don't look at the muzzle directly. It is extremely dangerous



Always keep the airgun out of children reach



Remove magazine and battery during storage. Set the fire selector to safe when unused



Be careful that BB bullets maybe fire out even if the magazine is removed.

This sport gun is developed for enjoying sport shooting only. As the Airsoft Gun has the potential risk of serious injury such as blindness and damage to the property, please read the Handling & Instruction manual before use.

- This Airsoft Gun is capable of shooting a 6mm diameter BB, Operate the Airsoft Gun with caution and pay attention to safety.
- During a game, always put your goggles or facemask on. Failure to wear eye protective gear in the worst case will cause blindness.
- Pay attention to and take care to not hit bystanders within the estimated dangerous firing zone.
- Never shoot any items that subject to breakage. (glass, lamp, car, gas bomb...etc)
- Never insert items other than an airsoft BB into the magazine or gun barrel.
- The gun must not be operated after drinking alcohol to avoid possible danger.
- Always store at place out of the reach of children
- Having a positive playing demeanor is essential.
- Select a safe place for operating the Airsoft Gun. Avoid places where people and cars pass across or third persons are around.
- Always put the gun in a case or bag when you are carrying it. Avoid giving rise to public panic.
- BB bullets maybe fire out even the magazine is removed. Direct the muzzle towards a safe area. Pull the trigger to confirm no bullets remain in the gun. Then attach the protective plug to the muzzle when unused.
- Remove the magazine and Co2 from the gun when unused.

Flipped Rear Sight



Press down this button to flip up the





Turn this wheel for sight alignment




Two way rear sight (small hole for aiming long range and big hole for aiming close range





- 1. Make sure to insert the cleaning rod AFTER returning the hop up lever to NORMAL position. (HOP OFF)
- 2. Insert the cleaning rod from the lead edge of the barrel
- 3. Be careful so that the angled part of the cleaning rod facing down and remove clogged bullets



Maintenance is needed when bullet speed becomes slow. Wrap a cotton cloth on the rod. Hold the leading end of the rod and insert rod into the barrel while turning the rod to clean the barrel inside



Loading 12g Co2 Capsule





Unscrew the whole end cap by the use of skull key or (Flat Screw-Driver)





Screw the whole end cap clockwise. Make sure the whole end cap is tightened to avoid gas leakage







Insert 1 x 12g Disposal Co2 Canister into the magazine with the correct direction as shown above




Turn the middle silver cap anti-clockwise as shown above to release the puncture of Co2 Canister (Essential)



Slide the bottom plate back to the magazine upon finish loading of the Co2






Your rifle will not go into safe mode when it isn't cocked, or charged, to fire. By pulling back on the charging handle, you can cock the rifle. Once its cocked, you can switch to "Safe" mode

Press down the bolt release catch to make the bolt and charging handle go forward to its original position

## Filling the magazine



1) Take out the magazine


2) Put the adapter that comes with the packaging onto the magazine lip



3) Load the BB from the top of the adapter with the use of speed loader




Flip Up Dinosaurs Sight (Front) (Optional)

Unscrew all the 4 screws highlighted above




The Gas Bolt alone




Remove the 2 screws underneath of the bolt

In case of nozzle failure, you may need to replace the nozzle. Do not attempt to replace the nozzle by yourself if you are not familiar with GBB maintenance.


Semi Auto



- Confirm your firing area is safe before firing.
- There are possibilities that no BB comes out after pulling the trigger. This may happen when • new magazine is inserted. Switch to Full Auto and fire 5 – 10 shots will solve this problem. ٠
- Charge the battery if the firing cycle become slow.
- Give the Airsoft Gun a rest of 5 10 minutes after firing 220 rounds in order to ensure long ٠ service lives of the motor and battery.
- If bullets are clogged, stop firing and remove the clogged bullets immediately.
- Service the Airsoft Gun with silicon oil as daily maintenance. ٠
- Hop up may be unstable for first 200-300 rounds after silicon oil is used, this is normal • operation of the gun.







- To Fire the pellet
  - 1) Switch the selector switch to Semi or Full Auto
  - 2) Pull the trigger



By producing backspin on the BB bullets, this system allows BB to fly straighter and longer



Variable Hop Up System

Adjust the hop up by using the hop tool provided in the packaging. Place the tool inside the ejection port perfectly before adjusting.





Pull the charging handle backward, lock the bolt plate up with pressing down the bolt lock catch on the other side



### Caution

- The best position is where the bullets fly horizontally and the longest flying distance is obtained.
- Turning excessively adversely affects the trajectory. Therefore stop turning the dial when bullets fly horizontally.
- Moving the lever too much towards HOP will cause bullets to clog. Firing the gun with clogged bullets will damage the nozzle.
- If the hop up is adjusted excessively and causing clogging of bullets, stop operating the gun immediately. Return the lever to NORMAL and remove the clogged bullet.
