






Always put the gun in a case or bag when you are carrying it. Avoid giving rise to public panic.
BB bullets maybe fire out even the magazine is removed. Direct the muzzle towards a safe area. Pull the trigger to confirm no bullets remain in the gun. Then attach the protective plug to the muzzle when unused.

• Remove the magazine and battery from the gun when unused.








Keep the airsoft gun in the "SAFE" position until you are actually ready to shoot. Then turn the safety to the other two positions.







- Rotate the barrel clockwise to disengage it from the receiver assembly and then pull it outwards to remove it




- Increase the separation between the equipment and receiver.
